Laboratory and Studio Chemical Safety Rules

- 1. Always wear appropriate personal protective equipment that is required for the laboratory, studio or shop area (i.e. goggles, gloves, labcoat, etc).
- 2. Wear appropriate clothing (No tank tops, shorts or open toed shoes).
- 3. Confine long hair.
- 4. Never work alone.
- 5. Never perform unauthorized experiments or work.
- 6. Never bring food or drink into the work area.
- 7. Never engage in pranks or horseplay.
- 8. Ensure waste material is disposed of according to UNI requirements (Check with Environmental Safety Coordinator if there are questions about disposal of waste chemicals, sharps and other related material).
- 9. Never remove chemicals or equipment from lab without permission.
- 10. Always read the label and follow any instructions provided by the instructor.
- 11. Ensure chemicals are labeled as directed by the University Hazardous Communication Plan.
- 12. Add acid to water never water to acid.
- 13. Pay absolute attention to what you are doing.
- 14. Always wash your hands before you leave.
- 15. Report all chemical incidents (including injuries, spills and mishaps to the lab supervisor).
- 16. Keep work areas tidy. Clean up work areas when finished with the day's work.
- 17. Familiarize yourself with the locations of emergency equipment (i.e. eyewashes, safety showers, fire blankets, fire extinguishers and first aid equipment).
- 18. Store chemicals and equipment as directed by the supervisor.
