## Appendix D Hazardous Waste Satellite Accumulation Area Rules and Responsibilities

- 1. <u>Never accumulate more than 55 gallons of hazardous waste or more than 1 quart of acutely hazardous waste on site.</u>
- 2. <u>The generator will provide the necessary containers for waste accumulation.</u>
- 3. All waste containers must be labeled with approved waste description tags or labels
- 4. <u>The container label must contain the words, "Hazardous Waste" and a description of the hazards of the contents of the container.</u>
- 5. <u>Satellite Accumulation areas must comply with preparedness, prevention, contingency plan, and emergency procedures.</u>
- 6. If one or more generator shares the same satellite area, each generator is responsible for their waste.
